1. Costa Rica Classic Itinerary (Dec 31st – Jan 11th, 2026)

Our Classic Costa Rica tour will take you to the most interesting places in the country: National Reserves and Parks, animal rehabilitation centers, gardens, sustainable coffee plantation and farm, zip lines, and boat rides on rivers and oceans. Experienced guides will educate you about the abundant gorgeous species of the tropics, taking you to the right spots to behold them for yourself!

Rather than a tour that contradicts your faith with dated dates that counter the creation and flood account, find out how the most up-to-date scientific research aligns with the biblical record! CENTRAL VALLEY - SAN JOSÉ

DAY 1: Arrive in **San José**, at Juan Santamaria International Airport (SJO) where your hotel shuttle will transport you to your first night's lodging hotel. There we will welcome in the New Year together and welcome you to Costa Rica with refreshments, a tour overview, and answer your questions. Lodging: **CityExpress Hotel**.

DAY 2: Wildlife Rescue Center – Traditional and Western Breakfast buffet at this modern hotel. Enjoy a guided tour of Costa Rican and foreign species, including famous capibaras. This is the largest wildlife rescue center in Central America, receiving more than 3000 wild animals a year. Their main goal is to rehabilitate and release the animals back into their natural habitat. Along with the sanctuary, the site also has the only hospital for wildlife in the country, a breeding program for endangered species, an education program and release sites that are private reserves of over 800 hectares of reforested areas! Lodging: CityExpress Hotel.

DAY 3: La Paz Waterfall Gardens Travel on a road with breathtaking views to the mountains and immerse in the authentic rain forest. La Paz Waterfall Gardens will let you behold many of the different species and plants that inhabit the Costa Rican jungle before we encounter many of them in the wild. Enjoy gorgeous hillside gardens, see some of the 50 species of hummingbirds in Costa Rica, try local cheese, take a picture in a traditional ox cart. Enjoy bountiful buffets in an open air restaurant next to waterfalls. From here, we will head to the Northern part of Costa Rica, La Fortuna. Lodging: Sueños Dorados Hotel.






SOUTH PACIFIC



Tour with Purpose Code of Conduct



Be a traveler who looks on the bright side of life, who **finds the good** on a rainy day.

Be a **friendly** person, even if it means getting out of your comfort zone and enjoy other people's presence even if you also like your time alone.

Follow guides' instructions, be on time, stay with the group, and be safe.

Respectable hygiene and dress (ex. wear deodorant (no perfumes as some people are sensitive), shower as needed, groomed appearance, no exposed cleavage or stomachs, skin tight clothes need to have loose coverings (ex. long shirt or short skirt over leggings), modest swimsuits (shorts, one pieces, or tankinis, no bikinis or thongs).

Responsible for own belongings. TWP may not be able to retrieve left items or may decide not to as it will hinder the trip for others.

Be considerate and respectful in your speech with staff, guides, hotels, fellow tourists, etc. (Refrain from profanity or religious slang such as Jesus Christ or OMG.)

Sleep in designated rooms (as decided by TWP staff who take requests into consideration). Only married couples and family members/friends as appropriate may share beds. No out of wedlock or different genders sharing bedrooms/sleepovers or being in hotel rooms alone as couples.

Technology (TVs, phones, etc.) **use must be edifying** and in consideration of getting the most out of the trip.

No smoking on TWP tours.

Stay in control of actions (ex.no drunkeness, no highs, etc). Limit one alcoholic drink permitted per post morning meal and at own expense.

Obey laws (ex. no underage drinking, no illegal drugs, prescription meds only used by those they are prescribed to).
