

CENTRAL VALLEY – SAN JOSÉ

DAY 1: Arrive in San José, at Juan Santamaria International Airport (SJO). Begin your time in Costa Rica by gaining an understanding of the history and culture of Costa Rica at the stately National Museum. A monumental piece of art itself packed with meaning as barracks turned into a museum, garden, and butterfly pavilion signifying the cessation of the national army. Here you will wonder at the symbolism of stone sculptures dating as far back as 500 BC, compare and contrast the design of everyday objects to that of your own culture, and be in awe of the artistic handiwork in 28 species of butterfly at their various stages of life. Learn how a child artist who mixed paints for her parents discovered the miracle of metamorphosis. This day will inspire you for the opportunities for art making ahead. Lodging: **CityExpress Hotel**.






EASTERN CENTRAL RANGE & TALAMANCA RANGE

DAY 2: Eastern Central Range with one of the best coffee tours in the area at the oldest processing plant and coffee plantation in the country that is now rainforest sustainable and fair wage! From a high point paint the blooming scene of a rural village. After tasting specialty coffee in the area, head to lunch at a picturesque bed and breakfast atop a hill. Choose a tropical plant from the manicured garden to capture on your canvas. Stay at a peaceful bungalow lodge next to a lagoon/river amidst the jungle foliage. Lodging: **Los Sueños del Bosque**.

DAY 3: Talamanca Southern Range We will travel through the cloud forests of the Southern Range and stay one more night at this peaceful nature-packed lodge. Enjoy an evening and/or morning nature bird watching walk, possibly seeing the famous resplendent quetzal. Pause to sketch a variety of flowers or the emerald and ruby of the iridescent quetzal. Lodging: **Los Sueños del Bosque**.



SOUTH PACIFIC

DAY 4: Quepos-Drake Bay Partake in a delicious cocoa tour in Quepos area. Take a boat ride on one of our most beautiful rivers in the country, the Sierpe River, through mangroves that will lead us into the ocean and our beachfront hotel. Drake Bay will serve as a mid-point to reach a national park on some people's bucket lists! Lodging: **Rancho Corcovado**.

Day 5: Corcovado National Park Be prepared for great flora and fauna sightings with professional guides in one of the reserves with highest biodiversity in the world, Corcovado National Park. It is packed with a great variety of wild animals, from all three types of Costa Rican monkeys to unusual tropical birds, mammals and much more. Later in the afternoon, we will head to Caño Island, for a world-class snorkeling tour. Lodging: **Rancho Corcovado**.






NORTHERN RANGE – ARENAL VOLCANO

CENTRAL VALLEY – SAN JOSÉ

DAY 9: Travel on a road with breathtaking views to the mountains and immerse in the authentic rain forest. Peace Waterfall Gardens is the grand finale of our trip. In this wildlife sanctuary, you will behold jungle cats, poison dart, blue jean, and red eyed tree frogs, the most dangerous snakes on the planet in a safe serpentarium, that is, and some of the 50 species of hummingbirds in Costa Rica. Hold the blue morpho, taste local cheese, take in the intricate designs painted on a traditional ox cart. Savor a bountiful buffet in an openair restaurant with the sound of waterfalls in the background. **CityExpress Hotel.**

DAY 10: San José Sit back and relax in the canopy within an aerial tram seeing the foliage from a bird's eye view, close your eyes and listen to the unfamiliar sounds. Find artsy souvenirs to remember your trip by or for loved ones. You'll have an art gallery of your own pieces to bring home as gifts and for memories too! Finally, experience a modern art museum in another country, a contemporary take on art tours, and notice your preferences. We may even get hands on in the museum's lab. Tour with Purpose Code of Conduct



Be a traveler who looks on the bright side of life, who **finds the good** on a rainy day.

Be a **friendly** person, even if it means getting out of your comfort zone and enjoy other people's presence even if you also like your time alone.

Follow guides' instructions, be on time, stay with the group, and be safe.

Respectable hygiene and dress (ex. wear deodorant (no perfumes as some people are sensitive), shower as needed, groomed appearance, no exposed cleavage or stomachs, skin tight clothes need to have loose coverings (ex. long shirt or short skirt over leggings), modest swimsuits (shorts, one pieces, or tankinis, no bikinis or thongs).

Responsible for own belongings. TWP may not be able to retrieve left items or may decide not to as it will hinder the trip for others.

Be considerate and respectful in your speech with staff, guides, hotels, fellow tourists, etc. (Refrain from profanity or religious slang such as Jesus Christ or OMG.)

Sleep in designated rooms (as decided by TWP staff who take requests into consideration). Only married couples and family members/friends as appropriate may share beds. No out of wedlock or different genders sharing bedrooms/sleepovers or being in hotel rooms alone as couples.

Technology (TVs, phones, etc.) **use must be edifying** and in consideration of getting the most out of the trip.

No smoking on TWP tours.

Stay in control of actions (ex.no drunkenness, no highs, etc). **Limit one alcoholic drink** permitted per post morning meal and at own expense.

Obey laws (ex. no underage drinking, no illegal drugs, prescription meds only used by those they are prescribed to).

In consideration of being permitted to participate in the Activities, the Participant agrees as follows:

1. **Assumption of Risk:** Participant acknowledges and voluntarily assumes all risks associated with the Activities, whether known or unknown, and understands that such risks cannot be eliminated regardless of the care taken by the Operator.
