CENTRAL VALLEY – SAN JOSÉ






TORTUGUERO / CARIBBEAN COAST

DAY 3: Tortuguero National Park Join us in search of the gigantic leatherback sea turtle (6 ft and 1000 pounds!) and the second largest the green sea turtle (4ft). Arrive by boat to this a vehicle-free town (watch out for bicycles though). Visit one of the most important national reserves for the conservation of marine turtles and jaguars. Settle in for a relaxing boat ride on serene waters! We will be surrounded by the breeze of the Caribbean coast and the Tortuguero Lagoon, while staying in a lodge with an over-the-lagoon restaurant and tropical pool. We will take a nature walk in the lush Tortuguero National Park. **Lodging: Mawamba Lodge.**

Day 4: Tortuguero National Park To start the morning in paradise, we'll have an early morning tour at the famous Tortuguero Channels, naturally-formed water passages packed with flora and fauna. Back at our hotel we'll enjoy a delicious lunch and rest up for a visit to the Tortuguero Mount with an amazing view point. To top it off, prepare for an exciting mid-night tour on the beach to look for the leatherback turtles coming to lay eggs, all with the help of expert guide. **Lodging: Mawamba Lodge.**








SOUTH PACIFIC COAST

TALAMANCA SOUTHERN RANGE



Be a traveler who looks on the bright side of life, who **finds the good** on a rainy day.

Be a **friendly** person, even if it means getting out of your comfort zone and enjoy other people's presence even if you also like your time alone.

Follow guides' instructions, be on time, stay with the group, and be safe.

Respectable hygiene and dress (ex. wear deodorant (no perfumes as some people are sensitive), shower as needed, groomed appearance, no exposed cleavage or stomachs, skin tight clothes need to have loose coverings (ex. long shirt or short skirt over leggings), modest swimsuits (shorts, one pieces, or tankinis, no bikinis or thongs).

Responsible for own belongings. TWP may not be able to retrieve left items or may decide not to as it will hinder the trip for others.

Be considerate and respectful in your speech with staff, guides, hotels, fellow tourists, etc. (Refrain from profanity or religious slang such as Jesus Christ or OMG.)

Sleep in designated rooms (as decided by TWP staff who take requests into consideration). Only married couples and family members/friends as appropriate may share beds. No out of wedlock or different genders sharing bedrooms/sleepovers or being in hotel rooms alone as couples.

Technology (TVs, phones, etc.) **use must be edifying** and in consideration of getting the most out of the trip.

No smoking on TWP tours.

Stay in control of actions (ex.no drunkenness, no highs, etc). **Limit one alcoholic drink** permitted per post morning meal and at own expense.

Obey laws (ex. no underage drinking, no illegal drugs, prescription meds only used by those they are prescribed to).
